



Designation of Authorized Representative Statement

A duly authorized representative may be designated to sign legal documents if such a representative is responsible for the overall environmental compliance of the facility from which the discharge originates. If a representative is designated to sign, then the permittee must submit to the Industrial Pretreatment Program a *DESIGNATION OF AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE (DOAR) STATEMENT*.
